- **Schools Food Tech Workshops**
 - Honey and Bush Tucker workshops will run on the first day of show for secondary students only.
 - Workshop tickets are \$15 each (incl GST).
 - Sessions are 30min each.
 - If you want to attend both sessions it is \$15 per student per session
 - Location: Somerville Rooms (Meet in Woolworths Food Dome Foyer)
- **Teacher Professional Development (TPD)**
 - **Teacher Professional Development days will happen throughout the year. Please keep an eye on our website to see when RAS is hosting the next TPD.**

 - Students with Companion Cards will be allowed 1 additional ticket (free).

 - For bookings made less than 2 weeks prior to the Show, payment is required at time of booking.

What is the cost for students and teachers?

Student tickets can be purchased for \$20 (GST free) per student. Teacher tickets are \$20 (GST free).

Are you able to provide a free ticket for carers of disabled students?

Yes, as long as the student holds a companion card, we can provide a free ticket for the carer.

Unfortunately, as per our terms and conditions, schools must meet the following criteria to be able to purchase tickets at our schools price:

- Schools defined as NSW and ACT public schools
- 'List of Registered Non-Government Schools in New South Wales'
- ACT Government directory of Non-Government Schools
- Homeschool's registered with the NSW Board of Studies

Are you running Food Technology workshops this year? When will they be? What do they cost?

We are running two different food technology workshops this year; bush tucker and honey. They will be running over the course of six days (all show days excluding weekends and public holidays).

Each workshop goes for 30 minutes; 9:45am, 10:30am, 11:15am

Tickets are \$15 (incl GST) per student and will have to be purchased alongside general entry show tickets. Teachers do not have to pay to supervise.

Do the tickets come with complementary public transport?

Yes, they will include same-day return public transport.

Can I bring my home-school children?

I have not confirmed numbers yet. Can I place a tentative booking and then amend the order later?

You can if you have not yet paid. All you have to do is login with the same account that you used to book the tickets and go to 'View my Registrations' and then press edit next to the appropriate event.

If you have paid it will be more difficult. If you wish to lessen the amount of students you have purchased, a refund may not be available to you. If you wish to increase, there should be no problem. Contact us or place an additional order.

Please be advised that if tickets are not paid for after the deadline update (7 days after making initial booking) the order will be cancelled and tickets will not be sent out.
